Health Ministry

Pleasant words are a honeycomb to the soul and healing to the bones: Proverbs 16:24

It takes just as much energy to say a positive word as it does a negative one. In fact, it may take even less. Research has shown that when we speak positive words even in difficult circumstances or troubling situations – our bodies relax. As we relax, blood flow increases, including the flow of blood to the brain. A well-oxygenated brain is much more likely to think creatively, make wise decisions, find reasonable solutions and generate answers to questions.

Positive words ease relationships and create an atmosphere of peace that is conducive to rest, relaxation, rejuvenation, and sleep --- all of which are necessary for good health.

On the other hand, contrary to popular thought, negative words do not release tensions. They keep the body in a state of tension, constricting muscles and blood vessels. Irrational, uncreative, unreasonable behavior is a secondary effect.

A continual flow of negative words causes relationships to suffer, which creates an atmosphere of disharmony and makes for fitful sleep and frayed nerves --- none of which are healthy,

One of the best things we can do for our over-all health is to transform our speech habits.



South Sacramento Interfaith Partnership (SSIP) is a group of 17 churches who support the Food Closet. The Food Closet is housed at Bethany Presbyterian Church at 24th St. and Fruitridge Ave.



Those who are eligible to receive food from the Food Closet are any hungry people in the zip codes of 95822, 23, 24,26,28,31, and 32. People can receive food once/month. They receive enough food for 3 meals/day for3 days for each member of the family.

In a typical month the Food Closet would serve 1450 adults, 1500 children, and 350 seniors--3400 people--each receiving food for 9 meals or food for 30,600 meals. The numbers have been going up recently--in April 08 they gave food to 3700 people; that is food for 33,300 meals.

The churches supporting the Food Closet are--Centennial, Chinese Grace, Florin, Hope, Oak Park, Sacramento Japanese, and Wesley Methodist Churches, Bethany and Faith Presbyterian, Parkside and Faith Community United Church of Christ, Fruitridge Christian Disciples of Christ, Lutheran Church of the Master, Prince of Peace, Unitarian Universalist Community and St. Anthony Church.

How Can I Help?

- 1) On the 1st Sunday of the month you can bring to church--canned meats, canned beans, vegetables, soup, tomato products, or fruit, macaroni and cheese, top ramen, pasta, rice, breakfast cereal, baby food, peanut butter(18oz) and paper bags.
- 2) The Food Closet is open 5 days/week-9-11:30. You can volunteer to work there (428-5290).
- 3) You can give money to the Food Closet. Make the check out to SSIP and put it in the white house that is on a table in the Narthex (Cash can also be put in it. Cash allows some items like dried beans and rice to be purchased in bulk quantities at a cheaper rate than you can get them at the market.
- 4) You can talk to Charlie Tucker and Betty or Jim Park. They and others pick up food donated by grocery stores and deliver it to the Food Closet.

More and more people need help in these difficult economic times--any help that you can give will be a blessing. Many thanks to all of you who have given so generously.
